

BASIC RADIO LINGO

- Over – I've finished speaking
- Say Again – Repeat your last message
- Stand-by – I acknowledge your transmission, but can't respond right now
- Go ahead – I can respond, go ahead with your message
- Roger or 10-4 or Copy – message received and understood
- Affirmative / Negative – Yes / No
- Out – Conversation is finished, the channel is clear for other users.
- **Traffic – Transmitted communications**
- 10-1, 10-100 and 10-2, 10-200 – bathroom break
- Going off Walkie – turning off the radio
- Walkie Check – used when coming back on the radio.
- Good Check – response to Walkie Check
- What's your 20 – where are you?
- Eyes On X- how you ask if anyone has seen a person or thing.
- Flying In – bringing onto the set.
- Switch to 2 (or 4 or 5) – move the conversation to an open channel
- First Team – the actors in a scene
- Second Team – stand-ins or doubles.
